What does the course include?

Small-group (max 6) tutorials covering:

- Lower limb trauma, inc:
 - Pre-tibial haematomas
 - Open fractures of lower limb
 - Compartment syndrome
- Hand fractures
- Tendon injuries
- Replantation/Revascularisation
- Fingertip injuries
- The failing flap
- Extravasation injuries
- Infections, inc:
 - Hand infections
 - Necrotising fasciitis
 - Infected breast implant
- Burns
- Skin cancers, inc: local flaps
- The ‘nuts & bolts’ of being a registrar
