Founded in 1946 in the aftermath of world war, as the British Association of Plastic Surgeons, the Association had the objectives of relieving sickness and protecting and preserving public health by the promotion and development of plastic surgery.

The aim of the Association was to advance education in all aspects of plastic surgery. Today, these objectives remain. However, techniques and expertise have progressed to the extent that plastic surgery needs to be understood in a modern, wider context.

Our Delegates

The Venue ICC Belfast

ICC Belfast (formerly Belfast Waterfront) is Northern Ireland's premier conference and entertainment venue, located in the heart of Belfast's vibrant waterfront district. This purpose-built facility offers 7,000m² of flexible event space, including a 2,200-seat auditorium and a series of multipurpose halls and meeting rooms.

The venue combines state-of-the-art technology with versatile spaces suitable for conferences, exhibitions, concerts, and corporate events. Its central location provides easy access to hotels, restaurants, and transport links, while floor-toceiling windows offer stunning views across the River Lagan.

Accessibility

ICC Belfast is perfectly placed at the heart of Belfast city centre, just 5km and 25km from George

Best Belfast City Airport and Belfast International Airport respectively. The transfer time from Dublin Airport to Belfast is only 90 minutes, offering another 180 route options to delegates and exhibitors.





Payment Terms

30 days from date of invoice. Please note we cannot confirm stand space until full payment of our invoice has been received.

Cancellation Policy

If an exhibition space has to be cancelled, the following conditions will apply:

- More than 6 months prior to the conference: a cancellation fee of 20% of the exhibition fee will be payable
- 1-6 months prior to the conference: A cancellation fee of 50% of the exhibition fee will be payable
- Less than a month prior to the conference: A cancellation fee of 100% of the exhibition fee will be payable.

Exhibition Space

Places are allocated strictly on a first come first served basis and are allocated ONLY when payment has been received.

The exhibition space has been carefully planned to allow the maximum number of companies to exhibit. It is imperative therefore that your stand does not exceed the size allocated to you. If your company arrives at the meeting with a larger stand, you will be asked to dismantle any part of the stand, which encroaches to the detriment of a neighbouring site.

Standard electrics for each stand include two electrical plugs. No electrical extension leads are available at the venue and all companies must provide their own.

Spaces between the exhibition stands must be kept free. No fittings, fixtures or signs of any nature are to be attached to the walls or fabric of the building and all stands must be free standing. Firms displaying heavy pieces of equipment must take adequate measures to protect floors from the damage.

Set Up

Information on set up and breakdown will be supplied one month before the conference. Exhibitors must be set up by the start of the first refreshment break. Access for setup after this time is solely at the discretion of the organisers.

Loss or Damage

Neither the venue nor BAPRAS can be held responsible for loss or damage to the exhibitors' stands or property. Obtaining the relevant insurance is the sole responsibility of each exhibitor.

The organisers reserve the right to alter the exhibition layout without prior notice. Applications received for space, and then confirmed, imply complete acceptance of the above conditions. If any matters or disputes arise, the decision of the Honorary Secretary is final.
